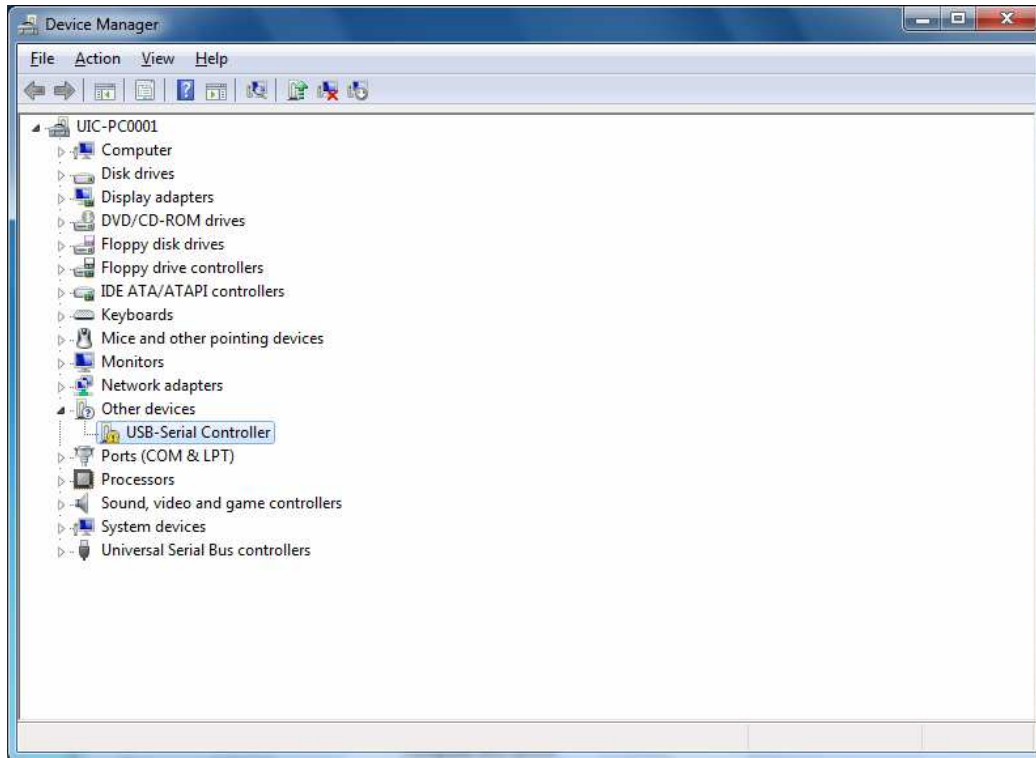


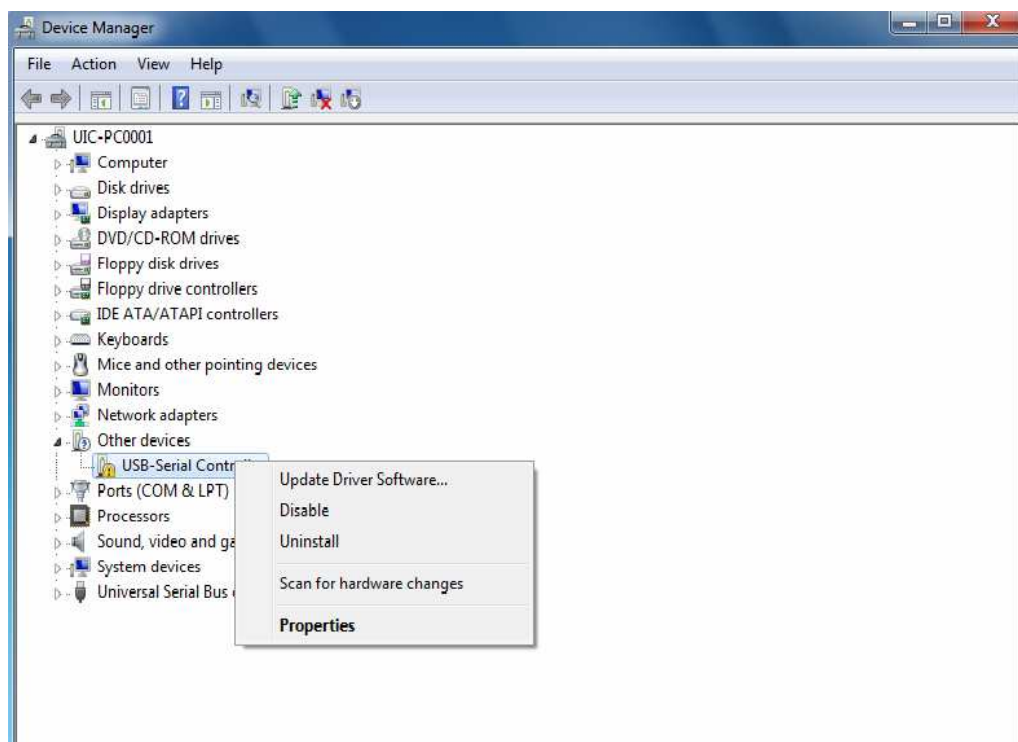
USB driver installation guide on Windows 7 system

This is a guide to how to install USB device driver on Windows 7® Operating System, here take one of the UIC products **MSR777-778 Card Reader** as an example.

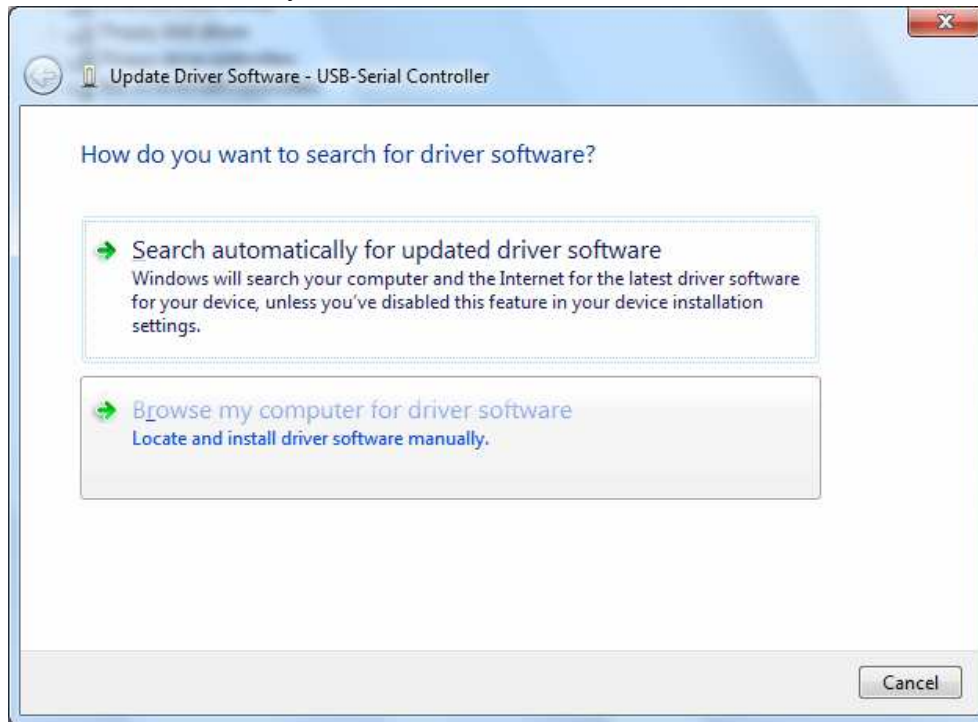
- Connect the reader to Windows 7 64-bit system.
- Go to Device Manager, which looks like the screen shown below.



- At Other devices, right click on the USB-Serial Controller and select “Update Driver Software”.



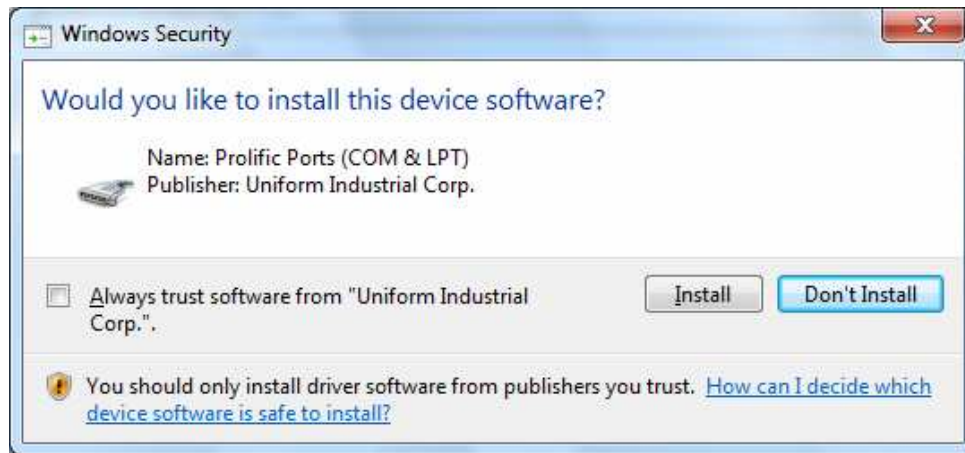
- Select the item “Browse my computer for driver software” to locate and install driver software manually.



- Specify the folder that contains the driver package.



- Click “Install” on the dialog box that asks “Would you like to install this device software?”.



- Click “Close” to complete the installation.



- Check Device Manager to see if the device is installed properly; a successful install should look similar to the below image. *Note that COM3 is the number of the COM Ports assigned to the device.*
